New Bridge School is an outstanding special academy, part of the New Bridge Multi Academy Trust (MAT). The New Bridge Learning Centre is the part of the school which provides for students aged from 16–19 years.

The Trustees would like to invite applications from experienced and qualified deliverers with a working knowledge of horticulture. The successful candidate is expected to lead the department within 2 or 3 years of appointment. It is envisaged that further allowances will apply when the role of department lead commences. The Horticultural Centre provides an opportunity for students to engage in a range of activities which include growing fruit, flowers and vegetables, and the maintenance of the school grounds including its lawns and shrub beds. Two large polytunnels allow for sowing seeds, taking cuttings and the growth of a number of semi hot house fruit and vegetables such as tomatoes and chilli peppers which are watered through an automatic system. The successful candidate will:

- Be able to demonstrate previous experience in a deliverer role teaching students from Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5
- Have a working knowledge of horticulture
- Have a full driving licence and be willing to become qualified to tow a trailer
- Be able to motivate students' progress and confidence
- Have specific experience with students with SEND
- Possess the emotional and physical resilience necessary when working with young people with a range of complex needs
- Have the ability to foster good relationships with other staff, students, parents and the wider community

The post will be initially based at our Fitton Hill site, although our staff are employed by the MAT and expected to work at any site within the New Bridge Group. All sites are within a 2 mile radius of the main Roman Road site. To arrange a visit, see below.
