New Bridge Multi Academy Trust (MAT) presently comprises New Bridge School, New Bridge Learning Centre, Spring Brook Academy, Hollinwood Academy (all situated in Oldham) and Hawthorns School (situated in Audenshaw). Our new AP free school, the Springboard Project, based in Oldham town centre has just opened in September 2019. We support the learning, social and pastoral needs of over 700 young people aged between 4 and 19 years.

The role involves general cleaning duties such as wiping down tables and surfaces, cleaning floors and toilets and using standard cleaning equipment such as mops and a vacuum cleaner.

You will be a member of a small team of cleaning staff and will need to be available to assist with a deeper clean of your particular site during the summer holidays.

Previous experience is essential although full training will be given. Key elements for any candidate are excellent attendance and reliability.

These are part time posts available on a full year basis. The details of the available posts are as follows:

- **Post 1:** 10 hrs per week, based at New Bridge School, Roman Road, Hollinwood. 2 hrs per day which can be worked either mornings or afternoons and will be negotiated with the successful candidate.
- **Post 2:** 15 hrs per week, based at Hollinwood Academy, Roman Road, Hollinwood. 3 hrs per day split across morning and afternoon sessions.
- **Post 3:** 10 hrs per week, based at the Springboard Project, Oldham town centre. 2 hours per day which can be worked either mornings or afternoons and will be negotiated with the successful candidate.
- **Post 4:** 20 hrs per week, based at the Springboard Project, Oldham town centre. 4 hours per day split across morning and afternoon sessions.

Please note that all staff may be required to work flexibly across the Group when needed.
