<p>Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents instructions for colour wheel and sandbox. • Firstly, open safari and put colour wheel primary and secondary colours. Then click on images. Choose an image that is clear and take a screen shot. • Open sandbox and click on red square at the top of the page. It takes you to another page that has a photo icon in the top right hand corner. Click on that and select your screen shot of the colour wheel. Then tap ‘to colour’ <p>Student activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at the coloured colour wheel and split screen with sandbox if poss. • Add the colours in the right place. • Talk about the colours with the person who is with you. <p>Extension:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn that red and blue make purple • Yellow and blue make green • Yellow and red make orange • That these six colours make the colour wheel. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take a screen shot of your work and also save it in the app. You can do this by pressing the off button and the home button at the same time. • Send an image to our Showbie group.
