Activities: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Go on the internet and look at some tower blocks, tower buildings. Do you recognise any? What do you notice? What is the general shape? <p>Other ideas: Can you locate these towers on a map? (Link to geography) Have you visited any towers ? Eg Blackpool.</p> <p>Use a range of material from around the house.
