<p>Learning Outcomes:</p> <p>To use the art app 'Art Set' to create a rainbow I can use collage to make a rainbow I can understand basic colour theory</p> <p>All over the country, children and their families have been making positivity rainbows to display in the windows of their homes. Some of the rainbows have been made by colouring or drawing but you could also make one from collage, paint or 3D crafts. Try some of these creative and fun ideas to make your own positivity rainbow</p>	
<p>Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents instructions for 'Art Set' • Firstly, Go into the students Self serve. This is the white square with coloured squares inside it. • Click on 'Art Set' this is a square with a pencil, crayon and tube of paint. • Click on the pencil to draw the rainbow. • Once drawn add the colours using the brush and the palette <p>Student activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a rainbow using art set • Put the colours in order, Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet. Use this as your design for your rainbow. <p>Second task: You can choose whether you do this and it would be nice to bring into school when all this is over and we will place them onto the walls around school.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Magazines <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start by looking through old magazines for blocks of colour and rip out pages with lots of colour on them. • Either rip the pages up into smaller pieces or cut them up using scissors. This is a great opportunity for younger children to practise their fine motor control by ripping or their scissor skills by cutting. Ensure scissors are handled safely and put away, out of reach, after use. • Ask an adult to help you draw a rainbow onto a piece of card or an old cereal packet. Now use white glue to attach the different pieces of coloured paper to the rainbow template. You may wish to sort the pieces of paper by colour into old yoghurt pots or bowls to make this easier. • You could also use: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • old birthday cards • old cereal packets or boxes • newspapers • junk mail • Take a screen shot of your work. You can do this by pressing the off button and the home button at the same time. • Send an image to our Showbie group. Showbie is an icon on the desktop.
