<p>Learning Outcomes:</p> <p>This activity is an opportunity for students to show me how creative they can get! This is designed to take 2 weeks (the Easter break).</p>							
<p>Activities:</p> <p>Using 'Pages' or 'Keynote' app, create a factsheet all about Easter!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose a topic focus. It could be animals related to Easter, the Easter story, the history of easter eggs – you can choose but it is important you focus on one topic. 2. Write your choice of topic as your title. 3. Find some important facts related to your topic and put these into your work. Try not to copy and paste information from the internet. 4. Change the font, font colour, font size etc of the facts (use the + button at the top right). 5. Add some pictures that link to your work (save these from the internet by holding the image down and choosing "Save image", then add it to your work using the + button at the top right). 6. Move the text / images on your screen to make your work look good! 7. Don't forget to add your name. 8. When you are finished, take a screenshot of your work. 9. Send the image via Showbie to the "Easter" assignment section (see video for help with this if you need it!) <p>I am going to make a video of all of the factsheets to go onto the NBS TV when we return to school. It would be brilliant to have as many contributions as possible so please send them over!</p>
