





Subject: Dance/Drama	Week: 6 Week plan/Week 2

<p>Learning Outcomes:</p> <p>I can engage in story telling by interacting with objects of reference.</p> <p>I can repeat actions, sounds or words.</p> <p>I can join in a simple dramatic activity.</p>	
<p>Activities:</p> <p>Students will listen and become familiar with the story “Lost and Found” by Oliver Jeffers (this can be found on YouTube).</p> <p>Week 2 – “Good weather and Bad”</p> <p>Play the story</p> <p>Arrange cushions or pillows in a boat shape on the floor so your child can climb in. Children could choose a favourite toy as a companion to sail off to the South Pole. Another cardboard tube or rolled up magazine would make a great telescope for spotting land, ships or danger. A brush with a long handle would make a great oar.</p> <p>Rock forward and back.</p> <p>Rock side to side.</p> <p>This week during the boat journey students will brave the elements of the weather. Using the following suggestions, create different weather elements for the students to experience while on their boat trip.</p> <p>Windy – A blowing fan/ paper fan. Use strong wind blowing sounds from YouTube for sound effects. Rock student backwards/forward/side to side.</p> <p>Rain – A water spray. Use rain sounds form YouTube for sound effects.</p> <p>Hot & Sunny – A hot water bottle and bright light shining onto student.</p>
