<p><b>Activities:</b>          Students will listen and become familiar with the story “Lost and Found” by Oliver Jeffers ( this can be found on YouTube).</p> <p><b>Week 3 – Make a HandPrint Penguin</b></p> <p><b>Supplies Needed to Make your Handprint Penguin :-</b>          White felt/paper/card          Black card/paper/ fabric          Orange card/paper/fabric          Googly Eyes – drawn on paper          ( if you don’t have coloured paper use felt pens or crayons on white card/paper)</p> <p><b><u>How to make your Handprint Penguin</u></b>          Trace around your hand using black paper/card and round the bottom of the handprint which will make the top of the penguin head.</p> <p>Decorate your penguins now! Add a round piece of white felt/card/paper for the belly, googly eyes, and cut out a diamond shape from the orange paper and folded that over for the beak.</p> <p>To make your round felt bellies, simply trace around a round object you have (like a bottle).</p> <p>What is your new Penguin called?</p> <p>Please send your finished Penguins to my email address <a href="mailto:spilgrim@newbridgegroup.org">spilgrim@newbridgegroup.org</a></p>
